



A GUIDE TO APPLYING FOR POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIPS

Background: RUFORUM has received a grant from Carnegie Corporation of New York to support Postdoctoral fellowship training. A component of the Fellowship support will be piloted with the National Crops Resources Research Institute (NaCRRI), a constituent of the Uganda National Agricultural Research Organization (NARO) and Makerere University, College of Agriculture and Environmental Sciences. The model for training will involve attachment of 4 graduate students at PhD (2) and Masters (2) level to the Postdoctoral Fellow's training under the mentorship of senior scientists from NaCRRI and Makerere University. Initially two Fellowship awards will be made.

Fellowship Application Procedure

The applicants should submit:

- A research proposal in areas of Horticulture (Oil Palm or tomato research), Beans or root crops (cassava or sweet potato research), maximum 12 pages, 1.5 lines spacing, font 12 times new roman. The proposal should articulate the rationale for the Fellowship, provide an overview of the Post-Doctoral Fellowship Programme, the proposed research thrusts, methodology, feasible work plan and clear deliverables. Importantly, the proposal should clearly articulate how the Fellow plans to integrate postgraduate students (2 Masters and 2 PhDs) who will be part of the research team but at the same time will be required to use the opportunity to conduct thesis research and finalize their dissertations leading to award of degrees. It should clearly also indicate how the Fellow will provide mentoring support to the research students and others and build his/her international networks.
- Provide result framework, budget and timeline to conducting the research
- A detailed motivation letter (max 2 pages), supported by a recommendation endorsement from their institution of employment and prospective Mentor at Makerere and/or NaCRRI.
- Copies of original tertiary qualifications, Copies of ID/passport documents and CV.

Financial Support

The fellowship includes:

- Stipend **\$1200** per month for 22 months.
- \$26700 to support participation of the Post-Doctoral Team that will include 2 PhD and 2 Masters Students to conduct research under the supervisor of the Fellow and Mentors at Makerere and NaCRRI. In the post-doctoral arrangement, partial support will be given to selected postgraduate students (at least two PhD student (\$12000) and 2 MSc students (\$9600) to cover field/upkeep costs, research paper publication and dissemination of findings, Student participation in conferences (\$3100) and follow up by the Fellow (\$2000)
- Special mentor support: **\$4,400** to be retained by RUFORUM Secretariat to support the Mentorship Programme. The cost of the mentors (2, one at NaCRRI and second at Makerere University) covers costs of the mentors visiting some of the research activities and participating in convening's along with the Post-Doctoral Fellows. NaCRRI will provide





accommodation for the Fellows and research costs of the two Post-Doctoral Teams.

• Administrative cost of **\$2500** to be retained by RUFORUM Secretariat to support air ticket (if Fellow is from outside Uganda) or Extend the Fellowship duration by one month.

Please note that the budget ceiling for the Post doc Fellowship is **\$ 60,000**.

Proposal Submission

How to submit a fellowship grant application via RIMS

- 1. After successfully logging on click 'Apply for a Grant'
- 2. Choose correct call ID which is RN/2020/Post Doc/02
- Complete the online application form.
 Please submit the detailed motivation letter, Copies of ID/passport documents and merged academic documents in the "support letters from.... "Section clearly labelled.

Selection criteria

RUFORUM relies on the professional expertise, experience and judgment of the reviewers in the Proposal review process.

The following key aspects will form criteria of awarding the applicants;

- i. intrinsic interest and merit of the work proposed;
- ii. the effect of Fellowship on university and expected future contribution of the Fellow;
- iii. the research contribution towards national or regional development;
- iv. commitment to establish a research team and strengthen supervision skills of Masters and PhD students, and the potential spill over to undergraduate students;
- v. the multi-disciplinarity of the approach, considering the graduate students to be trained
- vi. a well-articulated mentoring programme for the Fellow and for the students who will be under the Fellow's guidance/supervision
- vii. the potential contribution of the Fellow to building a critical mass of young scientists in Africa with a strong network to reinforce sharing of knowledge and approaches; and;
- viii. the feasibility of the work plan.

Time Frame

The foreseen time frame for the award process is as follows:

- i. The deadline for receiving applications at RUFORUM Secretariat is 27th May 2020
- ii. Administrative check / Compliance Review and feedback to applicants by 29th May 2020
- iii. Review of Proposals completed by $\mathbf{15^{th}}$ June 2020
- iv. Communication to Successful applicants by 19th June 2020.
- v. RUFORUM Secretariat sends out Grant Award letters by 29th June 2020
- vi. Grant advances disbursed by 9th July 2020
