SOKOINE UNIVERSITY OF AGRICULTURE College of Forestry, Wildlife and Tourism – REFOREST Programme PhD SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDEES









In May, 2020 REFOREST Programme hosted at Sokoine University of Agriculture (SUA) and supported by Sida announced a call for 20 PhD scholarships in Forest Sciences. Following this call, the programme received 334 applications (18% were female). The applications were evaluated in two phases: shortlisting and interviews.

During shortlisting, each application was evaluated by three independent reviewers using agreed criteria. The criteria captured the following: Academic qualifications (relevance and performance of BSc and MSc training), quality of the concept note (Background on the subject, Knowledge gap, Research objectives, Research methodology and Up to date references) and experience of the applicant (publications and work including research exposure). The average score of the three reviewers was used to rank and shortlist applicants. Shortlisted candidates were called for interviews.

Interviews were conducted at partner universities i.e. Hawassa Universityn (Ethiopia), Eduardo Mondlane University (Mozambique), University of Rwanda (Rwanda), Sokoine University of Agriculture (Tanzania) and Makerere University (Uganda) using agreed interview protocol. The protocol was applied consistently and objectively by the partner universities to assess the shortlisted candidates. The scores for the interviews and recommendations by the partner universities were presented and discussed by the REFOREST Programme Academic Advisory Committee (AAC) on the 30th of September, 2020. The AAC awarded each of the candidates listed below a 4 year REFOREST Programme Scholarship to undertake PhD studies in Forest Sciences at SUA.
